How can you encourage parents to be involved in School activities?



Invite them to School events

Personally invite them to attend School programs, exhibitions, or sports days to make them feel welcome and involved.



Involve them in field trips

Ask parents to join as volunteers or chaperones during educational trips to encourage participation.



Recognize their contributions

Thank and appreciate parents publicly during events or through certificates to motivate continued involvement.



Celebrate family and culture days

Host events where families can share traditions, food, or stories, promoting inclusion and bonding.

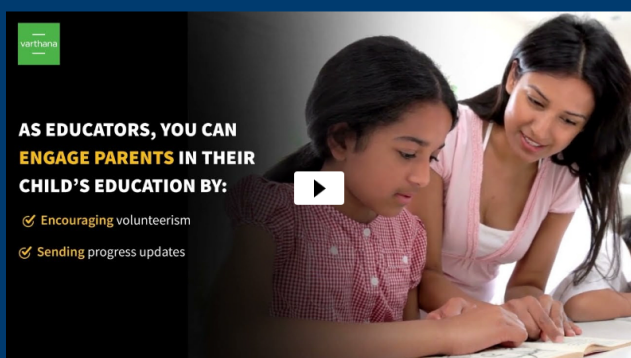
Importance of parental involvement in children's growth
